Nymans is a Grade 2 listed garden, with rare and unusual plant collections, set around a romantic house and ruins. The 13 hectare garden has one of the most comprehensive collections of Chilean and Argentinian species in the UK. In the walled garden there are plants from China and Chile. There are over 600 roses in the Rose Garden
